- Conduct comprehensive hazard assessments for each project and implement the necessary controls to reduce risks to as low as reasonably practicable.
- Provide awareness and training programs to ensure employee task competence relative to the improvement and fulfillment of HSE Management System.
- Provide a process for consultation on the HSE Management System and encourage employee participation at all levels of the company.
- Go beyond compliance to exceed all relevant health, safety and environmental laws, regulations, industry standards or any other applicable legal requirements.
- Reduce environmental risks by assessing the aspects of our activities and setting goals to reduce our impacts, including, but not limited to measures on pollution prevention and adaptation to climate change.
